

Byblos Bank Project Fact Sheet

Title of the Project	Byblos Bank Shouf Biosphere Reserve Bio corridor
Duration	3 years
Budget	\$100,000
Introduction	Reforestation of 15ha on the Bio corridor connecting the Cedar forest of Barouk and Maasser Al Shouf to the oak forests over Ammiq managed by the Shouf Biosphere Reserve Committee under long-term agreements with local municipalities
Activity 1	Purchase high quality seedlings from the Cooperative of Native Tree Producers in Lebanon to plant them on the site
Activity 2	Implement reforestation of 15 hectares on the Bio corridor connecting the Cedar forest of Barouk and Maasser Al Shouf to the oak forests over Ammiq
Activity 3	Fencing and maintenance of the reforestation site and set an irrigation system in the site
Activity 4	Organize communication activities for the Project and arrange for the involvement of the staff and all concerned parties in the Project
Activity 5	Guarantee the necessary and sustainable protection for their growth as well as the protection of the reforested land, namely through the implementation of the necessary policies to protect the land from grazing and any other action that might harm the planted seedlings.
